This form may only be submitted if an election has been held in this unit and at least one youth was elected.

Any adult who is currently active and registered as a unit, district, or council Scouter is eligible for nomination for membership in the Order of the Arrow. This form is only for the nomination of a Scouter 21 years of age and older. Those Scouts under age 21 must meet the youth eligibility requirements and be elected as a youth. **Please note: this is only a nomination for candidacy. In accordance with national policy, this nomination must be reviewed and approved by an Adult Selection Committee before the nominee becomes a candidate for membership in the Order of the Arrow.**

Troops or teams having less than or equal to 50 registered, active youth members may nominate one adult. Troops or Teams having more than 50 registered, active youth members may nominate an additional adult for every 50 registered, active youth or fraction thereof. (As an example, a troop having 51 to 100 registered, active youth may nominate two adults.)

(A) The same camping requirement set forth for youth candidates must be fulfilled by each adult nominee. Each nominee, after registration with a troop or team, must have experienced fifteen days and nights of Boy Scout camping during the two-year period prior to the election. The fifteen days and nights must include one, but no more than one, long-term camp consisting of six consecutive days and five nights of resident camping, approved and under the auspices and standards of the Boy Scouts of America. The balance of the camping must be overnight, weekend, or other short-term camps. This requirement may not be waived for adults nominated from a unit.
