

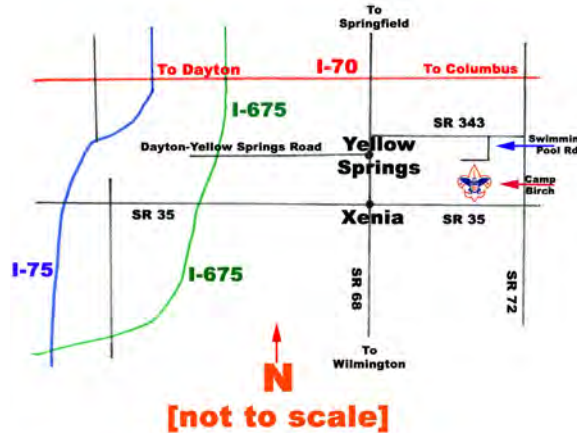

- Dormitory-style sleeping



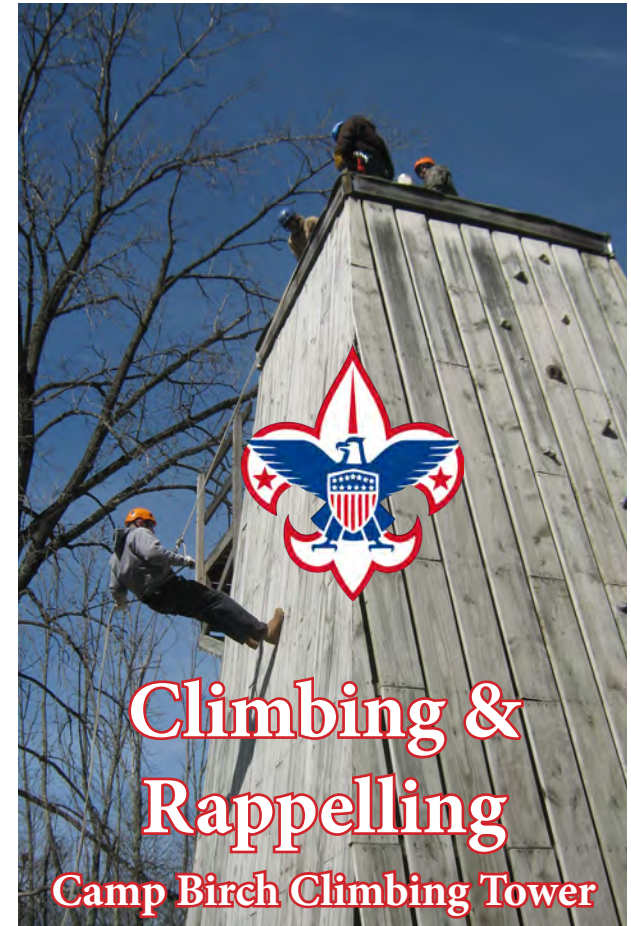
**From the North** - take Interstate 70 to State Road 68 South, turn left on S.R. 343 and follow it until Swimming Pool Road, turn right go until you see the camp entrance on the right.

**From the South** - take I-75 North to I-675 North, head East on Dayton-Yellow Springs Road through Yellow Springs, take a left on S.R. 68 and immediately take a right on SR 343, turn right on Swimming Pool Rd. go until you see Camp Birch on the right.
